I always thought it was funny that my church in Michigan was busy in the summer, but when it came to Christmas Eve services, there would be no more than 10-25 people in the church. mention this because it is ok to rest, relax, or vacation. We will be here all summer, in one way or another.

As we start summer know that the church is here for you and will be here for you as the summer ends too! May you have a great start to vour summer!






Friendship Circle


