

# **The Summer Giving Slump**

A term that has been coined by studies showing that weekly church attendance drops over 30% over the summer months. The same article from Tithely also states that "A drop in attendance brings a drop in giving - giving amounts drop 14% in the summer months, and typically don't recover until November." This can put a strain on our budget to cover expenses, even the planned ones.


You can help in a couple of ways. One – contribute your giving through on-line giving. Breeze allows you to give through either a debit or credit card or directly from your bank account through ACH - Automated Clearing House. ACH is the same method used by employers and the government to deposit money directly into your bank account. The other way you can always mail in or drop off your giving at the church office when you're in town in between Sunday services. You may contact the church office and get the information to set this up for yourself.

We're not trying to alarm you that we are out of money as we do have a reserve that carries us through the summer. But, if you're like me, once your budget gets thrown off, it feels like it takes a long time to get things back on track.

So enjoy your summer vacations, family reunions, camping trips and other activities. Please consider keeping up with your gifts to the church as we continue to take care of the business of the church. Our prayers are for everyone to have a fun and safe summer.




